The Olympic Games include competition in Archery, Basketball Foul Shooting/Accuracy, Beach Volleyball, Billiards, Bocce, Bowling, Cornhole, Darts, Fencing, Golf, Horseshoes, Miniature Golf, Pickleball, Racquetball, Swimming, Table Tennis, Team Softball, Tennis, Track & Field and Volleyball.

Our outstanding competition venues such as the Woodbridge High School stadium and athletic fields, newly installed pickleball courts in Fords Park, Majestic Lanes Bowling Center, and more make Woodbridge Township the ideal stage for Senior Olympians to showcase their talents. **ROADS AND PARKING LOTS:  
DRIVING AND PARKING**

*For the purpose of this article, "quasi-public property" is defined as private property upon which the public is invited to drive and park motor vehicles for the purpose of the business or businesses maintaining the same and shall specifically include private parking lots and driveways connecting the same to public streets.*

Drivers should be reminded that on quasi-public property, should they operate their motor vehicle in any manner which would, if committed upon a public highway constitute a violation of keeping to the right, parking on marked lines, reckless or careless driving, would also constitute a violation and subject to a summons. Vehicle operators should keep in mind that no person shall park any vehicle across any line or marking designating a parking space, or park a vehicle in such a position that said vehicle shall not be entirely within the space designated by such lines or markings, or park any vehicle in such a way as to prevent another vehicle from parking in any adjacent space. Additionally, no truck with a manufacturer gross vehicle weight rating of eight (8) tons or higher, shall park on any street or quasi-public area except for making pick-ups or deliveries. This includes a bus used to transport 16 or more passengers (including the driver); truck trailer; truck semi-trailer; or recreational vehicle. Any of the aforementioned parked in excess of 30 minutes without any unloading or loading activity shall be presumed to be parked in violation. For this purpose, recreational vehicles shall include boats and trailers used for family or personal purposes, and self-propelled or towed that serve as temporary living quarters for recreational camping or travel purposes. Such violations are subject to enforcement by the Woodbridge Police Department.
